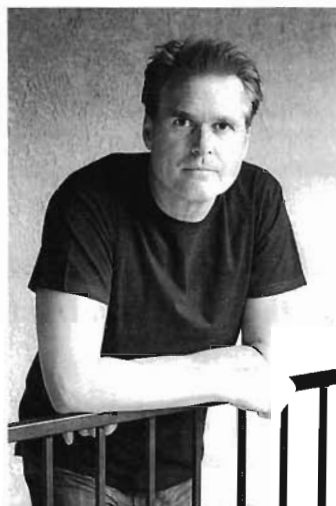

For the past 25 years, Lorin Miller has enjoyed performing nationally and internationally in Japan, China, Europe and the Philippines in a variety of styles ranging from Bach to Broadway. Lorin, a California native, grew up in Grass Valley. His undergraduate degree is from

Additionally, Lorin serves as an adjunct professor at William Jessup University in Rocklin as the Music Intern Director and part-time vocal instructor.



Pamela Marich was born in the Midwest. Although her younger years were spent belting out tunes on the stage of her high school gym, her later years saw her cast for roles in South Pacific, Paint Your Wagon, and Godspell. After years performing in jazz ensembles, choirs, classical concerts, big bands and various solo performances, Pamela used her experience to produce a wide variety of concerts and musical productions, and has partnered with Lorin Miller to create an organization called A Gift of the Heart. A Gift of the Heart is an organization to promote the arts for the purposes of education and development of local talent of all ages through the creation of quality, wholesome musical and artistic experiences. 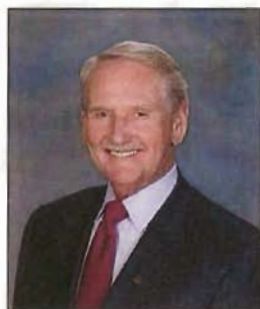
